6. PURPOSE / AIM

There are two workplace focused skills programmes - one focuses on environmental practitioners within NGOs, Government Departments etc developing educational support materials and one has been focused on educators within schools for developing environmental materials to support the National Curriculum Statement (NCS).

8. COURSE SPECIFIC OUTCOMES INCLUDE:

- Identify a need for environmental learning support materials
- Conduct research to determine form and content of materials required
- Design and develop draft materials for the particular context
- Pilot-test the materials and get feedback from stakeholders in a practical hands-on manner
- Revise the materials based on feedback and field-testing
