6. PURPOSE / AIM

Within this skills programme learners will explore a range of barriers to learning that their learners can experience within the learning process. There are two workplace focused skills programmes - one focuses on environmental practitioners within NGOs, Government Departments, etc developing educational programmes and one has been focused on educators within schools developing classroom based environmental programmes within the National Curriculum Statement (NCS).

- Demonstrate how learning programmes can enhance participation of learners with special needs

- Develop with stakeholders a framework for an environmental learning programme
- Select a contextually-relevant environmental learning programme
- Plan, adapt and organise an environmental learning programme.
