- Develop a code of environmental ethics guiding practice within the field of work or study
- Explore and clarify principles of environmental justice and sustainability
- Analyse a selected environmental issue in terms of principles of environmental justice
- Discuss and recommend possible solutions
- Evaluate proposed solutions in terms of environmental justice and sustainability.
